EVENT INFORMATION

FREESTYLE DIVISION

Basic Rules:

- Freestyle is 2 minutes & Competitors can use up to 10 Frisbees. (All must be of same weight & size).
- Toss & Fetch Round is 90 seconds - scores from top 5 catches are counted. Maximum score is 22.5

Qualifier Class: These competitors will perform 2 rounds of Freestyle & 1 Round of Toss and Fetch. Total score from all 3 rounds will determine placements. ***This class is open to all COMPETITORS that want a chance to qualify to attend the USDDN World Championships in October.***

Open Class: These competitors will perform 1 round of Freestyle and 1 round of Toss & Fetch. The total score is determined by multiplying the freestyle score by 3 and adding the Toss& Fetch total to determine placements. ***This class is for all competitors not wishing to attempt to qualify for USDDN Worlds***

Super-Pro Toss and Fetch

Basic Rules:

- Toss and Fetch Round is 90 Seconds - scores from top 5 catches are counted
- There is a 5 yard wide bonus zone from the 10 yard line through the 40 yard zone. Catches in this zone are awarded .5 pt bonus. Maximum score is 25.

Qualifier Class: These competitors will perform 2 rounds of Super-Pro Toss & Fetch. Total Score from both rounds will determine placements. ***This class is open to ALL Competitors that want a chance to qualify to attend the USDDN World Championships in October.***

Open Class: These competitors will perform 2 rounds of Super-Pro Toss & Fetch. ***This Class is for all competitors not wishing to attempt to qualify for USDDN Worlds.***

USDDN Rules Notes:

- A team** is defined as a Dog & Handler. A dog can compete on multiple teams and can qualify for Worlds with each team, however the dog may only compete on ONE team at Worlds in each division.
- Any team that has already qualified for USDDN World Finals during this competition season will be "by-passed" while calculating the Qualifying teams from this event. This will not affect their tournament placement at this event.
